TASTING NOTES

Colour: Inky deep purple.

Bouquet: Dark berries, with a hint of herbaceousness and mocha, cedary overtones.

Palate: Cassis and plum with soft, supple tannins giving great definition and mouth-feel on the palate. A hint of vanilla and coconut on the finish is due to the management of oak leading to a lovely, elegant, lingering finish.

Cuisine: Simple winter meat dishes, such as casseroles, pasta meals and European dishes

Fruit: The Cabernet fruit for this fabulous wine has been drawn from the gravelly soils of Gingin. The Cabernet was picked when the fruit flavours were at their peak and natural acids of the fruit were in balance. This lovely fruit has led to the production of a wonderfully balanced wine.

Winemaking: Picked and processed in the cool of the evening, the grapes were partially crushed and a percentage of whole berries were left to ferment in the must. This ensured a level of carbonic maceration and enhanced the cherry flavours. Both French and American oak was used to build upon the intense fruit flavours and to enhance the
