OLD WELL SHIRAZ

Vintage: 2006
Variety: Shiraz 100%
Region: Perth Hills
Alcohol: 14.5%
Cellar: 8+ Years

TASTING NOTES

Colour: Deep crimson red with purple hue.

Bouquet: Dark berry and integrated spice aromas.

Palate: A firm, medium-bodied style with plenty of primary fruit flavours of plum and mulberry with subtle smoky oak characters. Abundant soft tannins complement the strength and flavour of the wine with a lingering pleasant finish.

Cuisine: Tender Beef Casserole

Fruit: The fruit for this wine has been sourced from the vineyards of the Chittering Valley. The vines are grown on gentle slopes of gravely brown loam over clay, with regular granite outcrops. The Mediterranean climate and altitude of the region produces classic bold fruit flavours.

Winemaking: Harvested and processed in the cool of the evening, the grapes were partially crushed and a percentage of whole berries were left to ferment in the must. Leaving whole bunches during primary fermentation produces aromas and flavours of cherries, cinnamon and perfume. As a result it makes the wine fruitier and more appealing to drink.
